"Dear lucky family that has found Diane,

My name is Melanie and I am mom to a 4-month-old girl and 2-year-old boy. When I was preparing to deliver my daughter, I realized I would need help in the hospital overnight. I needed to have a C-section and I was concerned that I would not be able to get out of bed to respond to the baby's needs. Despite family help, my son would need my husband and everyone else would need their rest. I was reluctant to hire anyone, wanting it to be someone special to me during this important time. It was, I just had not met her yet.

Diane was recommended to me by our full-time nanny, who has worked with her and known her work with children over the years. Diane made herself available to me despite the fact that Tessa arrived on Christmas. She was with me every night in the hospital. Tessa took to her immediately, as did the rest of the family. It was such a comfort to have her watching over my daughter with me during this important time. Her skill, knowledge, and savvy with newborns and infants was clear as was her love for my baby and her genuine desire to nurture her and support me in doing so as well. She would cuddle the baby when I could not be with her, and bring me the baby at every opportunity. She taught me how to swaddle and supported the baby in falling into deep sleep with the swaddle. She also supported me in my feeding and learning generally how to care for the baby. She also went above and beyond in helping me in my recovery and in meeting my needs, making me feel very comfortable during what can be a very uncomfortable and personal time (recovering from surgery, etc). At one point when a concern arose (my daughter's initial oxygen count was not registering where we wanted

it to be – turned out to be a fluke of the machine/timing and all was well) she was efficient and invaluable in getting my nurse and supporting me in understanding what was happening and what was needed. I thought I would dread the time that my family members left our hospital room each day, but within a few minutes of that first night of four in the hospital, I looked forward to my time with her and tried to learn all I could. Moreover, with her watching the baby I was confident in her care such that I too could sleep, eat, and heal. I am confident that it is thanks to her that my baby and I had such as positive hospital experience and had so much relaxed bonding time.

We continued to hire Diane for a few nights a week for our first month or so at home. We did not have help with our son and his sleep was and continues to be a big problem. Diane was absolutely willing to take the baby to another room and let me sleep while supporting my daughter in sleeping through the night in a swaddle. I wanted to learn from her, however, and not repeat the mistakes I made with my son. She would take care of the baby at night but also demonstrate to me what she was doing and coach me in doing it myself, be in swaddling, timing putting her down, soothing her to sleep without lifting her, burping...everything that came up. And when there were nights that I was so sleep deprived I just needed rest she would bring me the baby to feed on demand and then take her to be soothed to sleep across the room. And it was always such as pleasure and a comfort to have her. For me, my husband, and I am convinced, for my daughter.

As an aside, she minimally interacted with my son as he would be asleep when she arrived and often asleep when she left. However, though they only met a few times briefly in the early morning, he too formed such a strong positive connection with her it was wonderful to see. I highly recommend her for your care needs. "My family and I first connected with Diane via care.com around January 2017. I was expecting my first child in March 2017, and with no family within an hour's drive and minimal parental leave for my husband, I knew I wanted to identify a local expert I could count on to provide support for me and the baby. I wasn't sure what to expect with parenthood and didn't know exactly what I was looking for in terms of hours from a Newborn Care Specialist, but my priority was finding someone whom I could trust completely with my precious newborn.

I found Diane to be very supportive of me as a new mother and able to offer guidance and advice on request, without being judgmental or overstepping.

A year or so later, when we learned we were expecting my daughter in February 2019, Diane was one of the first people I

let know! Again, she started with us when my daughter was less than a week old and continued to support us for about four months, and we again had a fantastic experience.
